



## NOTICE OF EMERGENCY MEETING

Notice is hereby given that the Board of Regents of the University of Nebraska will hold an emergency meeting in a publicly convened session on Monday, February 19, 2024 at 4:00 p.m. via videoconference in the Boardroom at Varner Hall, 3835 Holdrege Street, Lincoln, Nebraska.

The only business to be conducted by the Board of Regents at such emergency meeting will be the consideration of a motion to go into closed session as authorized by Neb. Rev. Stat. § 84-1410 for the protection of the public interest and to prevent needless injury to the reputation of persons who have not requested a public hearing for the purpose of a discussion limited to confidential personnel matters involving the search and selection of the President of the University of Nebraska.

Members of the public wishing to address the Board during the Public Comment portion of the meeting *in-person* will continue to follow the provisions of Standing Rule 5.1. Members of the public wishing to address the Board during the Public Comment portion of the meeting *via remote participation* must contact the Corporation Secretary no less than 24 hours prior to the commencement of the meeting (no later than 4:00 p.m. on Sunday, February 18, 2024). Upon receipt of such notice, the Corporation Secretary will provide instructions on remote participation in the public meeting.
